The major changes to the ANZAC March which occurred last year will continue this year.





As reported briefly in the February Newsletter the **MAJOR CHANGES** made to last year's March apply again this year. Our WW2 veterans remain near the front in Group 5 and the AEME/RAEME Association members are in Group 12A.

Frank Owen has arranged with the March Committee for RAEME Vietnam Veterans to march as a separate RAEME group in Group 10B. If you are eligible and wish to march with this group contact Frank, his phone number is 8384 7291.

Assembly Areas

- WW2 Veterans - Northern Side of North Tce
- Association- Northern Side of Grenfell St and west side of Pulteney Street.

Any ANZAC Day March queries should be directed to our Unit Guides, Brian Holmes on phone (08) 8362 3216 or Mike Culley on phone (08) 8294 3820.

The route is the same as last year, from the starting point (Kintore Ave), West along North Terrace, North along King William Road and right into Sir Edwin Smith Avenue to the dispersal area in Pennington Gardens.

Salutes (the Association Banner is to be lowered on the "eyes right") are to be paid at the National War Memorial and the South African War Memorial on North Terrace, and the Official Dais on the eastern side of King William Road near the Parade Ground at Torrens Training Depot.

Vehicles will be available for veterans who can no longer make the distance.

Please let Don Harvy know (08) 8387 6169, mobile (0403 996 224) or email (harvyfamily@iprimus.com.au) if you require a seat. The vehicle will return passengers to Pulteney Street immediately after the marchers have been dismissed at the end of the March. **The RSL is providing the vehicle(s) and they will form a "Pod" of vehicles behind each group.** This is to prevent marchers directly behind the veterans from being forced to breathe exhaust fumes.

Carers:

One carer or wheelchair pusher is permitted to assist a veteran within unit ranks.

March Conduct and Paying of Compliments

Unit flags, banners and roundels are to be lowered for all salutes. Yellow unit identification signs are to remain upright and facing the front at the saluting points, except on approaching the Official Dais, where they are turned half-right for the salute on the order EYES-RIGHT and then returned to face the front on the order EYES-FRONT.

Civilian, ex-serving and retired members of any rank are more than welcome to attend as long as they are properly attired and do not display poor behaviour. However, current serving members who are not eligible for membership of a Sergeants' Mess are not invited to attend and should attend their rank respective Mess. **Mess protocol dictates that all personnel attending the Mess should introduce themselves as a member of the AEME/RAEME Association to the PMC or the senior Mess member.**




